

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2019-20

Attached is the list of various scholarships which are available at this time. Please note the following procedures as you select those for which you wish to apply.

1. Scholarships listed in this packet are available to all Milton High School seniors. **Unless otherwise noted, applications are available on the school district website at www.milton.k12.wi.us. Click on the counseling link.**
2. **BEWARE OF DEADLINES. Scholarships are due in the counseling office by deadlines listed in this packet, NOT deadlines printed on the scholarship.** We have to allow time for processing and mailing. **LATE SCHOLARSHIPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED—NO EXCEPTIONS! SCHOLARSHIPS ARE DUE BY 2:00 P.M.**
3. The scholarship packet is updated frequently. Check emails for announcements, stop in the counseling office or check the counseling website for updated lists.
4. Some scholarships require essays, photographs, letters of recommendation, etc. and it is **THE STUDENT'S** responsibility to take care of this. Don't expect letters of recommendation to be completed in a few days. Contact people for letters of recommendation well in advance so they have adequate time to write the letter. **Be sure you have all supporting documents asked for by the sponsor before turning in your applications.**
5. All scholarships are numbered. Please reference that number when requesting applications in the counseling office. They are numbered in order in which they are received and if they are standard or individual and not in numerical order on the page.

17. GREEN-ROCK AUDUBON SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: APRIL 20, 2020

AWARD: Two of \$1,000

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior living in Rock County, Green County or Lafayette County.
2. The applicant has the intention of studying biology, geology, environmental science, conservation, or other subjects related to the mission of Green-Rock Audubon.
3. The applicant's written reason and commitment are worthy of funding and the applicant self-identifies as a minority in their field of study.
4. A written essay is required.

67. BADGER CHORDHAWK SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: April 6, 2020

AWARD: One of \$2000

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is pursuing a four-year degree program with a minor or major in vocal music education, performance, or instruction.
2. Letter of Recommendation from a professional musician, private voice or instrument teacher/coach, high school choir, band or theater director, or other recognized music professional who can attest to your background and aspirations is encouraged but not required. 68. PREMIER ORAL & MAXILLOFACIAL SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD: One of \$1,000

DEADLINE: APRIL 21, 2020

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is entering the medical or dental field.
2. Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
3. 300 words or less essay & transcript required.
4. **Pick up in the counseling office.**
5. **Turn in completed application to the counseling office.**

83. POLISH HERITAGE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2020****AWARD:** Up to Two of \$1000

Eligibility criteria:

1. Applicant must be of verifiable Polish ancestry OR studying the Polish language, history, society or culture OR be significantly engaged with Polish culture.
2. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident.
3. Applicant must be a Wisconsin resident.
4. Applicant must be enrolling or enrolled in an educational program seeking the associate or bachelor's degree in any field of study an accredited U.S. university or college.
5. Applicant has demonstrated excellent academic performance. Successful applicants will usually have a grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a four-point scale.
6. A 750-1000 word essay, career plan, and ancestry description are required.

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is planning to attend a Wisconsin public or private college or vocational technical institute.
2. Must include 500-1,000 word double spaced typed essay addressing the following topic: "What strategies can Wisconsin use to recruit and retain fire and EMS volunteers?"

96. NATIONAL ART HONOR SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP**DEADLINE: APRIL 6, 2020****AWARD:** One of \$250

Eligibility criteria:

1. Senior must be planning on attending and accepted into a technical college, community college or four year college.
2. Must major in the visual arts (drawing, painting, sculpture, jewelry, ceramics, photography, computer graphics, web design, animation, game design, printing, art education, architecture, industrial design, art history etc.)
3. Must have a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average.
4. Must have a minimum of 4 semesters of art class at Milton High School.

5. Must have a minimum of 2 years participation with National Art Honor Society.
6. Must currently be an active member of the National Art Honor Society during senior year.
7. Must submit a physical art portfolio demonstrating a sample of your best work. (A minimum of 10 examples).
8. Submit one current letter of recommendation from a teacher, not from the art teacher(s).

98. CARRIE CRYSTAL STUCKERT MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIPS

AWARD: Two of \$2,000
Three of \$1,000

DEADLINE: APRIL 15, 2020

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who will be an Art Major (including Art Therapy programs) at an accredited institution of higher education in the U.S.
2. Must possess extracurricular accomplishments and inspirational goals.
3. Autobiography and two letters of recommendation (one from an art instructor) are required.
4. **Pick up application in the counseling office.**
5. **Turn in completed application to the counseling office.**

99. AB NICHOLAS SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: APRIL 30, 2020

AWARD: Up to 65 of \$10,000 for four-year programs – renewable *or*
\$5,000 for two-year programs – renewable

Eligibility criteria:

1. Live in Wisconsin and attend a Wisconsin public high school.
2. Participate your senior year in your school's boys or girls basketball program, as a player or manager.
3. Must plan to attend a University of Wisconsin System school.
4. Based on financial need.

100. JESSICA JOY ARNOLD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: APRIL 09, 2020

AWARD: One or more of approximately \$2,000

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who has been accepted to an accredited college or university.
2. Must have GPA of 3.0 or better.
3. Must show leadership (preference will be given to those who have been actively involved in 4-H, Future Farmers of America, or the Arabian Horse Association).
4. Include at least two letters of recommendation, one from a high school teacher and one preferably from a youth activity director or employer.
5. Must submit transcripts, ACT score report, and a copy of college/university admission letter.

3. Must demonstrate financial need; must be Pell Grant eligible.

DEADLINE: MAY 01, 2020

AWARD: Four of \$125

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is a current member of the track and field team and has been in track all four years.
2. Must be in good standing with the track team (no track discipline or inability to play due to poor grades)
3. Must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher
4. **Pick up application in the counseling office.**
5. **Turn in completed application to the counseling office.**

DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2020

AWARD: Four of \$500

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is continuing education coursework (construction related classes) including seminars, vehicle or equipment training etc.).
2. The committee will be basing applications on the applicant's interest in construction, extracurricular activities, employment experience, personal evaluations and applicant's requests.
