DIRECTIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL APPLICATIONS

(All scholarships that follow require individual applications)

- Individual scholarship applications are scholarships that are not a part of our standard scholarship application process. Each scholarship listed in this packet has a unique application that you need to either complete and turn in to Ms. Williams in Student Services or complete and turn in online or by email directly to the sponsor.
- Please read each scholarship's criteria carefully. Some scholarships will have web links where you can apply directly online for their scholarship, and other scholarships will have paper copies of their applications that you will pick up in the Student Services Center.
- All scholarships that state they need to be turned in to the Student Services Center must be turned in at 2:00 PM on the date listed in this packet.
- Some scholarship deadlines will be different than what is listed in the application. Please make sure you are using the deadline listed in this packet. Ms. Williams mails a lot of the applications on your behalf for the entire class. There is more time needed to review and mail applications and often sponsors want applications in hand on the date of their specific application. No late applications will be accepted.
- Some scholarships may require additional materials such as essays, letters of recommendation, a photograph, etc. Make sure you read each scholarship's criteria carefully.
- Ms. Williams in Student Services can help you get copies of your transcript or other school-related materials.

INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

PREMIER ORAL & MAXILLOFACIAL SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD: One of \$1,000

DEADLINE: APRIL 3, 2024

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is entering the medical or dental field.
2. Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
3. 300 words or less essay & transcript required.
4. Scholarship is awarded after student completes the first semester of college and is enrolled in 12 credits. GPA must be 3.0 to receive award. Present the first semester report card to Premier Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery for award
5. **Pick up in the Student Services Center.**
6. **Turn in completed application to the Student Services Center.**

GREEN-ROCK AUDUBON SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: APRIL 20, 2024

AWARD: Two of \$1,000

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior living in Rock County, Green County or Lafayette County.
2. The applicant has the intention of studying biology, geology, environmental science, conservation, or other subjects related to the mission of Green-Rock Audubon.
3. The applicant's written reason and commitment are worthy of funding and the applicant self-identifies as a minority in their field of study.
4. A written essay is required.

AB NICHOLAS SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: APRIL 30, 2024

AWARD: Up to 65 of \$10,000 for four-year programs – renewable *or* \$5,000 for two-year programs – renewable

Eligibility criteria:

1. Live in Wisconsin and attend a Wisconsin public high school.
2. Participate your senior year in your school's boys or girls basketball program, as a player or manager.
3. Must plan to attend a University of Wisconsin System school full time (at least 12 credits).
4. Based on financial need. You will need to complete the FAFSA form for your application to be considered

WISCONSIN TOWNS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS

DEADLINE: May 24, 2024

AWARD: 7 of \$1000

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is planning to attend a Wisconsin public or private college or university.
2. Must include 500-1,000 word double spaced typed essay addressing the following topic: "What strategies can be implemented by town officials in collaboration with citizens to maintain civility in local government?"
