Job Description:

The School District of Milton is seeking an energetic **Educational Sign Language Interpreter** to assist a High School student for the 2017-2018 school year. This individual will be responsible for interpreting class content, voicing for the student, and facilitating communication with hearing peers and school personnel. Other duties include tutoring, participation in meetings, and being an active member of the student's educational team.

Qualifications:

The School District of Milton is seeking a highly qualified individual with strong American Sign Language (ASL) skills who will work collaboratively with general and special education staff. Candidates should be organized and flexible, as well as demonstrate strong communication and interpersonal skills. The optimal candidate will have a 3.5 on the Educational Interpreter Performance Assessment (EIPA) or higher (preferably a 4.0), and a strong desire to support student development, growth and achievement in all areas. Additional expectations may include interpreting for after school activities.
