

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION MAKING

The Board of Education believes the schools belong to the people whom they are contracted to serve. The Board endorses the concept that community participation in the affairs of the schools is essential if the school district and the community are to maintain mutual confidence and respect and work together to improve the quality of education for all students.

Board members themselves will remain mindful that they are elected to represent the people of the district. In addition, all citizens of the district will be encouraged to express ideas, concerns, and judgments about the schools through such means as (a) written suggestion(s) or proposal(s); (b) responses to surveys, made through interviews, written instruments, or other means; (c) comments at meetings of the Board; and (d) service on citizen advisory committees.
