

Immunizations:

- Wisconsin Law requires that all students have a record of their immunizations at school by the start of the school year.
- Please refer to the “Student Immunization Law” handout to determine which immunizations your child may need.
- If you choose not to immunize your child, please fill out the waiver on the bottom of the Student Immunization Record and return it to school.
- Completed forms can be turned in at the High School or mailed to the address above.

Medical Conditions:

- Please contact me before school starts if your child has any medical conditions that we need to plan ahead for, such as:
 - ♣ Diabetes
 - ♣ Seizure disorder
 - ♣ Severe allergies that require an Epi-pen
 - ♣ Asthma
 - ♣ Any other condition that requires a health procedure that needs to be performed during the school day.

Medications:

- Please read through the Medication Policy included in this packet
- Prescription and non-prescription medication permission forms are available in the school office and on our website.

Communicable Disease Letters:

- If a communicable disease (such as head lice, pink eye, etc) is diagnosed within your child’s classroom, a letter will be sent home.
- If your child is diagnosed with a communicable disease, please inform the office right away. This is very important to help prevent the spread of these diseases.
- All information is kept confidential.

A few other things....

- Please take time to teach your child proper hand washing techniques. It is the number one defense against the spread of illness!
- We realize that young students may have bathroom accidents, but we do expect your child to be potty trained before starting school.
- If there are any other health concerns you may have, please contact the school nurse.
