Recommended supply list for all students:

Folder and notebook for each class, flash drive, pens, pencils & earbuds

Agriculture Department - all courses require the recommended supply list noted above

Art Department- All art classes require a \$10.00 fee for each semester. This covers many of the needed art materials. Students are responsible for the following items::

Art 1, Art 2, Beginning Drawing, Advanced Drawing and AP-2D:

1 dozen #2 pencils, handheld pencil sharpener, 12" ruler, 4 white drawing erasers, 6 extra fine point black ink pens, 1 pencil bag (no bigger than 6"x 8").

Beginning Painting and Advanced Painting:

1 dozen #2 pencils, handheld pencil sharpener, 4 white drawing erasers

Digital Photography:

Digital camera (5mp or higher) with a USB interface cable or SD memory card, 2" 3-ring binder, 10 plastic sleeves to keep photos, 1 extra fine point black sharpie pen

#2 pencils, 1 extra fine point black sharpie, 1 spoon, 1 fork, 3 chain necklaces

World Language- all courses require the recommended supply list at the top of this page

All French Classes:

For students who prefer to take notes on paper rather than electronically: Slim (½" - 1") 3-ring binder with 8 tab dividers, loose leaf paper

For all students: pocket folder (3 hole punched if using binder), 3 fine-point or ultra-fine point dry erase markers (any colors)

Recommended for French 1, required for French 2 and above: Pocket French/English dictionary (Larousse or Collins-Robert preferred)

All Spanish classes:Spanish dictionary, 2" or 2 ½ " 3-ring binder

AP Spanish: Spanish dictionary, 2" or 2 ½ " 3-ring binder, cassette audio tape
