Developing Our Plan: 3 Core Areas Of School Safety

- **People and Plan Safety:** *Connecting response plans, procedures and protocols for responding to critical incidents and communicating in them with our people*
- **Emotional Safety:** *Connecting students to our schools and community*
- **Structural/Environmental Safety:** *Creating structurally safe/secure learning environments*

Physical Safety

- We annually review response plans and monthly discuss ways we can improve safety
- All schools train in the crisis response plan including fire and tornado drills and non-emergency and emergency lockdowns
- Our Crisis Response Plan uses research based best practices

Emotional Safety Programming Initiatives

- Social and emotional skill lessons
- Behavioral curriculum
- Mental health grants
- Staff professional development in trauma informed care
- De-escalation training
- Handle with care program



Structural Safety

- A focused effort on safety within our Capital Improvements and Maintenance plan
 - Initiatives Include:
 - Secure entry sequence remodels
 - Security camera and access control upgrades
 - Parking and on-site traffic flow improvements
 - PA system upgrades
