Milton Summer School Program General Information

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the 2019 School District of Milton Summer School Program! At this time, we would like to remind you of some information about summer school dates and times, as well as to elaborate on information regarding your child's class schedule and shuttle bus procedures.

Class Schedule

Families with a Skyward account can access their child's summer schedule in Skyward.

Families that registered with the paper registration form received their child's schedule via email when their child was registered. The numbers listed along the left side of the schedule (under the days of the week) indicate the class session.

Session 1 runs from 8:15 to 9:45 a.m., while session 2 runs from 10:00 to 11:30 a.m. Sessions other than 1 and 2 have different dates and/or times outside of our typical scheduled classes.

Supplies

On the first day of school, your child should bring their own pens, pencils, glue, crayons and scissors. The only exceptions are physical activity classes (for example: Organized Games & Sports, Flag Football, Basketball, etc.).

Dates

All four week enrichment and remedial classes begin on Monday, June 10 and conclude on Wednesday, July 3. The six week high school courses for credit begin on Tuesday, June 11 and conclude Friday, July 19, with the exception of the Bridge to Algebra, and HS Health and Physical Education classes which start on June 10. There are no classes Thursday, July 4 or Friday, July 5.

Shuttle Buses

Shuttle bus services are provided between session 1 and 2 (9:45-10:00 a.m.) to transport students whose classes are located in different buildings. School personnel will be located at each school bus stop to ensure that students get on and off buses safely. All of the buses stop at all buildings, so it will not be necessary to assign students to a specific bus.
