Milton High School Announces National Merit Scholar Commended Students

Milton, WI- Milton High School is pleased to announce that two students have been named Commended Students in the 2018 National Merit Scholarship Program (NMSC). MHS Principal Jeremy Bilhorn was recently notified that seniors Sean Harvatine and Erin Swope have been named Commended Students in the 2018 National Merit Scholarship Program. A Letter of Commendation from the school and National Merit Scholarship (NMSC), which conducts the program, will be presented by the principal to these scholastically talented seniors.

About 34,000 Commended Students throughout the nation are being recognized for their exceptional academic promise. Although the Commended Students will not continue in the 2018 competition for National Merit Scholarship awards, Commended Students placed among the top 50,000 scorers of more than 1.6 million students who entered the 2018 competition by taking the 2016 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®).
