ANNUAL STUDENT REGISTRATION OPENING SOON

We hope all of our Red Hawk families and staff members are enjoying a fun, relaxing summer. Believe it or not, we're already halfway through break and it's almost time to register for the new school year. **Our first day of school will be Tuesday, September 1 and annual student registration will be opening very soon.**

Annual registration is completed online through Skyward Family Access. **Unfortunately, Skyward is undergoing nationwide extended maintenance.** We do not have a solid timeframe for when it will come back online. Once Skyward returns to full service, we will be able to open up online registration for families. We will share updates via social media and robocall/text.

DON'T FORGET! BUS REGISTRATION DUE BY FRIDAY, JULY 31

Families planning to utilize bus transportation to get their student(s) to and/or from school, please don't forget to complete the **Online Transportation Registration Form** by Friday, July 31. This form is *required every year* to be routed for transportation, even if your student rode the bus last year.

Forms submitted after July 31 will not be routed in time for the first day of school. Late registrations may not be added to routes until mid-September, so please be sure to register on time.

Families who do not qualify for free transportation may be eligible to participate in the Buy-A-Seat program. If this applies to your household, GO Riteway will contact you directly after your registration form has been submitted.

ATHLETIC REGISTRATION IS OPEN FOR MMS AND MHS ATHLETIC

If your child is planning to play sports at MMS or MHS this year, the time to register is now. The District is moving to a single platform called Bound to make things much easier. You will now be able to handle sports registration, event schedules, and ticket buying all in one spot.

How to Register:

1. Go to the [Milton Bound Page](#).
2. Click on "Register" in the dropdown menu.
3. Create your account and follow the quick steps.

Don't Forget the Sports Physical! Please make sure your student athlete has an up-to-date physical on file. Here is how to know if they need a new one for the 2026-27 school year:

- Completed before April 1, 2025: You need a new physical.
- Completed between April 1, 2025 and March 31, 2026: You are good for one more year.
- Completed after April 1, 2026: You are good for two years.



DON'T MISS OUT: SCHOOL MEAL & FEE ASSISTANCE INFO

If your students qualified for free or reduced meals through the direct certification process from the state for the upcoming school year **you will have received an email from the nutrition team.** This email contains important information about the district's fee assistance program. Sometimes this email lands in the junk or spam folder so please make sure to check there if you are unable to locate it in your regular email account.

For any families not directly certified you are encouraged to fill out the free and reduced forms. You can do this by filling them out online when registration opens through your skyward family account. You may also stop by the district office or MHS and pick a paper copy. If you have a printer at home the forms are also located on the district website. <https://www.milton.k12.wi.us/district/nutrition-services/forms/>

Once the paper forms are completed you may return them back to the district office or MHS. You can drop them off in person or mail them. Be sure to address the envelope with (Attention: nutrition department).

Please note **if you qualified for free or reduced meals for the 25-26 school year and you didn't receive the email showing you qualified for this upcoming school year you must fill out a new application for the 26-27 school year.**

SETTING OUR NEW MIDDLE SCHOOLERS AND FRESHMEN UP FOR SUCCESS: HS 101 AND MAKING THE MOVE

We want to make sure our students feel completely ready and confident when they step into their new schools this fall. To support our Red Hawks, we offer two transition programs this summer to help incoming 7th and 9th graders get their bearings.

High School 101 (Incoming Grade 9)

This fast-paced, exciting one-week course helps incoming freshmen prepare for life at Milton High School. Students will tour MHS, learn their schedules, and meet staff and classmates.

Designed specifically for our incoming 7th graders, this three day program helps students practice daily routines, even how to open combination lockers. It is a perfect way to meet future MMS teachers and classmates.

YOUNG INNOVATORS AT WORK: CAMP INVENTION AT MILTON WEST

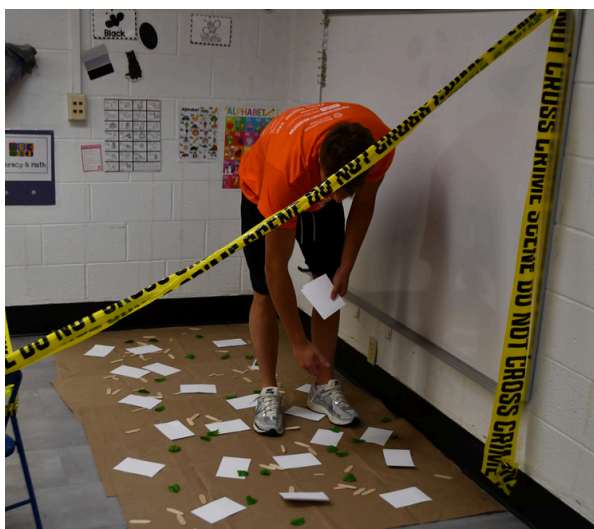
Milton West was filled with the sounds of tinkering, testing, and problem-solving during our first session of Camp Invention. Led by Milton educators and volunteers, this program gives students in grades K-6 a chance to step into the shoes of real engineers and inventors.

Throughout the week, campers jumped into hands-on STEM challenges, building their own working prototypes, testing "DNA" of capybara "crime scenes," even building their own model planets.

On top of the gadgets and projects, Camp Invention helps kids stay curious over the summer months.
